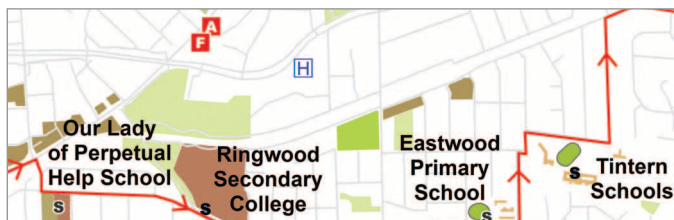


Custodianship FAQ

How will becoming a formal custodian help me and my organisation?

This is a big question, but in a nutshell it formalises and acknowledges what you are already doing. It gives you a structure to work in with ready-written agreements and role descriptions. It establishes you as the “authority” for your data. Custodians report that putting their data under the spotlight and widening its use has helped justify improvements and has significantly boosted morale.

Other organisations will share their data with you. This can improve your decision making or save the time and cost of collecting data yourself.

What is the difference between the Custodian and the Custodial Officer?

The Custodian is the organisation which takes responsibility for the accuracy, currency, storage, security and distribution of a dataset. The Custodial Officer is the person who ensures the dataset is documented, maintained and distributed according to the agreed standards.

I am appointing the Custodial Officer. Is there any documentation that will help get them up to speed?

If my contact details are published for dataset enquires will I be inundated with questions?

Instead of publishing a name, you can have a phone number (this should be a direct line) and the email can be custodian@your.organisation.au so that it can be easily redirected. SII can field initial calls or you can engage a third party to handle these and dataset delivery.

What is the role of SII in all this?

Spatial Information Infrastructure (SII) is part of the Department of Sustainability and Environment. SII provides the custodianship framework, templates, assistance and advice and creates awareness of your datasets through the Victorian Spatial Data Directory

I need to get the heads of each department on side. Can you help?

Yes. We can supply a presentation which you can use ‘as is’ or tailor to your organisation. In addition, a member of the Custodianship Team is available to present to your management.

The Victorian Spatial Council (VSC) has directed the Spatial Information Infrastructure Division in the Department of Sustainability and Environment to manage the Custodianship Program on its behalf.
